CORRIGENDUM

In partial modification of Order F. No. MSERC/RPO/COMP/2024/250 dated 4th November 2024, the Meghalaya Non-conventional and Rural Energy Development Agency shall continue to be the “State Agency” as per Regulation 2.0 Definition and Interpretations and sub-clause t.

However, in exercise of the power conferred under Regulation 9.5 and Regulation 23.0 of the Meghalaya State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Renewable Energy Purchase Obligation & its Compliance) Regulations, 2018, the Commission hereby directs that the Meghalaya State Load Despatch Centre (SLDC), in addition to its functions as a Verifying Agency shall assume with immediate effect the following functions previously assigned to the State Agency:

- a. Maintaining and settling accounts in respect of certificates,
- b. Repository of transactions in certificates, and
- c. Shall formulate procedures and develop RPO Compliance and Monitoring Web Tool for RPO compliance monitoring and reporting. It may also suggest appropriate action to the Commission, if required, for compliance of the renewable purchase obligation.
- d. Shall carry out other functions incidental to the implementation of renewable energy certificate mechanism as may be assigned by the Commission from time to time.

Accordingly, functions assigned to the State Agency under sub-clauses 9.1(c), 9.1 (e), 9.1(f) and 9.3 stand withdrawn.

It is further directed that all the obligated entities to submit the RPO compliance report within 15 (fifteen) days after the quarter ending, to the SLDC, to ensure that the Commission receive the compliance reports promptly.

Furthermore, the obligated entities concerned, as to be determined by the SLDC, are directed to furnish all claims of meeting the RPO, with all supporting

certificates/documents, to the SLDC for verification of RPO compliance from the FY 2018-19 onwards.

In respect of those obligated entities claiming RPO compliance through Captive Power Plants, the Verifying Authority, in accordance with sub-clause 2.1 u. of the Meghalaya State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Renewable Energy Purchase Obligation & its Compliance) Regulations, 2018, shall continue to be Inspectorate of Electricity, Government of Meghalaya.
