ORDER

- 1. The above batches of Miscellaneous Applications were filed by the individual Members of Byrnihat Industries Association (BIA in short) against the same respondents. The issues involved and the reliefs prayed are also same. Thus, the above stated batches of Miscellaneous Applications are hereby disposed of by a common order.
- **2.** That the Commission vide Order dated 19th July 2023, had admitted the Miscellaneous Application and registered as under:

3. That the present applications have been filed by the Petitioners against the Respondent for non-compliance of the Orders dated 05.12.2022 and 11.07.2023 passed by the Commission, whereby the Respondent was directed to realize the electricity bills from the Petitioners as per the Special Tariff.

- **4.** That the Commission had fixed a hearing for the applications on multiple occasions. However, the matter was adjourned several times.
- **5.** On 12th March 2024, the Commission took up the applications for hearing. However, at the request of the parties and in view of the consensus that the Main Case, namely, MSERC Case Nos. 11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19 & 20 of 2022 be taken up for hearing and decision and thereafter these applications be taken up, the Commission adjourned the Applications to be taken up subsequently. Extract of the Order dated 12th March 2024, is reproduced below:

"Parties represented by respective counsels present for the hearing. Counsel for Petitioners as well Counsel for Respondents are in consensus that initially the Main Case, MSERC Case No. 11 to 20 of 2022 be taken up for hearing and decision and thereafter this Miscellaneous application under Section 142 and Section 146 of the Electricity Act, 2003 can be taken up.

- **6.** That the Commission vide Order dated 4th July 2025, has disposed of the Main Case namely, MSERC Case Nos. 11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19 & 20 of 2022.
- **7.** Accordingly, the present Miscellaneous Application No. 1 to 5 of 2023, stands disposed of in terms of the said Order.
- **8.** Further all interim orders are also vacated.
